

Prelude to Sunrise

1. Drum procession with accompanying niggun
2. Pause to read creation story until Day 4
3. Readings/Poetry/Music
(including the Ibn Gabirol poem)
4. Reading (with over-reading) of Genesis 1:14-19
5. Recitation of the beracha at the first curve of the sun's presence
6. Blowing of as many shofrot as we can gather
7. Singing of "Here comes the Sun"

Service

1. Recitation of Blessings offered by participants
2. Psalm 148
3. Recitation of Barchu followed by High Mountain Yoga pose and singing of "esah aynai"
4. Eil Adon
5. Recitation of the "Shema"
6. Quiet time/Shemoneh Esrei
7. Excerpt from the "Yehi Ratzon" chosen by Everett
8. Aleinu
9. If mourner's are present, Mourner's Kaddish
10. Recessional with Drumming to Kaya's Adon Olam
11. Burning of the Chametz
